Reception

The reception area seats up to 110 guests and is a charmer with its macrocarpa ceilings and panoramic outlook of the Ruahine Ranges. Your table setting will be ready upon arrival and a simple touch of your flowers or candles completes the look beautifully. In cooler months you can experience the ambiance of having our open log fire crackling away.

We take care of background music and provide microphones for speeches. Once the formalities of the evening conclude celebrate the night away; being a true country venue you do not need to worry about noise infringements! When you are ready to retire for the evening, the onsite accommodation provides an effortless flow.







Menus

We offer a delicious collection of buffet menu options with fresh produce sourced from our vegetable garden and a local meat collection. All dietaries can be catered for and we like to ensure the food is bountiful so there is always plenty for seconds!

Our boutique bar has a wide selection of beer, wines, spirits, RTDs, and non-alcoholic beverages. Bar tabs can be set up or guests can pay as they go. BYO Wine is permitted (corkage charge applies) with a limit of 2 bottles per 10 adults.

Accommodation

When you choose Makoura Lodge for your wedding you will gain use of our wonderful accommodation options from the afternoon before your wedding. Makoura Lodge has accommodation for up 52 people on a shared basis. We have six modern suites attached to the main Lodge, two cottages: Burnside cottage and Glenluce homestead. If our accommodation is booked by a minimum of 40 guests, we allow camping and caravans to stay.

Burnside Cottage is perfect for bridal party preparations with its charming native timbered interior and hallway arch. Two nights' accommodation is included into our Wedding Packages for the bridal couple and you have the option to stay in the Lodge accommodation (Package One) or the secluded Riverside Retreat (Package Two).

Post Wedding Breaky

Reminisce with your guests the next morning over a delicious, cooked buffet breakfast and barista coffee at 9am. As the Makoura dream team do all the cleaning up all you need to do is take your décor home (walk-in walk-out venue!). We have a leisurely check-out time of 11 am so no need to rush! You have the option to extend your stay another night to wind down at the River Retreat, soak in the outdoor tub, and watch the stars together as newlyweds!

Pricing

Your guests can make payment upon check-in. The following pricing is a flat rate across all the accommodation. Please see our terms and conditions for important lodging information.

Pricing includes one full cooked breakfast on the day after the wedding.

Wedding night: \$96 pp | Two nights: \$162 pp
Adult BnB rate – for 20 to 30 guests staying
Wedding night: \$128pp | Two nights: \$200 pp
Children BnB rate (5-12years)

Wedding night: \$75 pp | Two nights: \$134 pp

Children BnB rate (under 5 years)

Wedding night: \$60pp | Two nights: \$120pp (no charge if staying in a porta-cot & is halved if sharing a bed)

Caravans & Camping BnB rate

Wedding night: \$52 pp | Two nights: \$76 pp (permitted only if more than 40 guests staying onsite)

Booking Process and Payments

Upon booking

\$1000 deposit is required alongside our booking form (please email us).

Six months prior to your wedding

The Cost of your Package Choice is due .

10-14 days prior

- Catering
- Corkage if applicable
- Estimated bar tab (any unused will be refunded)
- Any optional extras you choose

Day after

Any extras or unpaid accounts (including your guests).

10-14 days after

Any damages will be taken off the \$1000 deposit. If all is well this will be refunded back to you within 14 days.

2024 Terms and Conditions

Your responsibilities

- Any decorations that you wish to use such as flowers, candles, guest books, signs, aisle and archway decor. It is your responsibility to set up your decor and to dismantle and remove from the premises. We have the right to charge a setup fee should you ask us to set up any of your decor and/or a disposal fee for any decor that is left behind.
- Music choice- you cannot beat live music but if you would like to use our sounds system, we will play your playlists for you. Spotify is available.
- Choice of your vendors. We will provide you with a list of useful contacts, but you are responsible for choosing your own photographer, celebrant, makeup artists, bands, florists etc.
- Your table seating plan. We can provide an easel to present your seating plan on. A1 sizing for your seating plan is ideal for our easel size.
- Any damages or requirement for additional cleaning (for example due to the hair from hessian runners, inorganic confetti, spilled candle wax, glitter or jelly balls) may incur extra costs. Stained tablecloths will incur a dry-cleaning fee or if replacement is necessary a replacement fee will apply. Extra cleaning fees will be deducted from your deposit or added to your final account.
- You are responsible for ensuring that no food or alcohol (other than BYO allowance, baby food and wedding cake) or dangerous goods are brought into the lodge or garden areas.
- At least 14 days prior to your wedding date, we require a completed copy of your planning information guide. This includes your accommodation plan, table layout plan, final catering numbers, schedule, menu choices, beverage information and additional requirements.

Accommodation sleep plan

Your sleep plan is required 14 days prior. Makoura Lodge reserves the right to charge for the number of stays notified on your sleeping plan that is received ten days prior to your Wedding date, even if less stay than advised.

Accommodation minimum stay

Upon booking we will hold the accommodation for the night of your wedding and the night prior. Therefore we have a minimum stay the night before your wedding of ten guests and night of your wedding of twenty guests, or payment equal to that amount. Camping/ caravans will be permitted if there are more than 40 people utilising our accommodation. Unused accommodation the night prior to your wedding will be released once we have received your sleep plan.

Accommodation guest payment

Your guests will be asked for payment upon check-in. Any unpaid guest payments or damages will be added to the final account or deducted from the \$1000 deposit. For accommodation pricing children are classed as under the age of 12 years. There is no charge for babies sleeping in our or your porta cot.

Accommodation-bridal

The accommodation for the bridal couple in Package One includes two nights (the night before and night of) at the lodge accommodation (Glenluce, Burnside, or the lodge suites). The accommodation for the bridal couple in Package Two includes the night before the wedding at the lodge accommodation and the night of the wedding at the Riverside Retreat.

Accommodation-linen/towelling change overs

The BnB rate is based on guests staying in the same room if staying longer than one night. We include three free bed change overs if you are needing to re-allocate rooms. Any more than three will be charged at \$35 per bed.

Cancellations or wedding date changes

A change to your Wedding date may be agreed at our discretion if more than 12 months' written notice is provided. An administration charge of \$200 applies. A new booking form is required.

If you provide us with more than 12 months' written notice of the cancellation of your wedding date, we may refund you up to 40% of your \$1000 deposit at management's discretion.

Your \$1000 deposit will not be refunded if you cancel your booking within 12 months of your wedding date.

Your Wedding Management & Venue Hire will not be refunded if you cancel your booking within 6 months of your wedding date. Your deposit will also be retained by us due to the late cancellation and unlikeliness to re-book another wedding.

Your deposit, wedding management & venue hire cost, and your total meal payment will be required/not refunded if you cancel your booking within fourteen days of your wedding date.

Confirmation of menu and final numbers

The number of guests confirmed 14 days prior is the minimum number charged for catering regardless of whether fewer guests attend.

We are open to discussion around menu changes but due to overhead costs, any agreed changes will not result in a charge less than the cheapest buffet option offered by us. Excluding dessert reflects negatively on the venue therefore it is included in all menus.

Exclusive use

We will provide you with exclusive use of the lodge on the day of your wedding. The accommodation will be exclusive to you the night of your wedding. Riverside Retreat may be vacated by another party if you have not booked it.

Makoura Lodge reserves the right to host functions the day before your wedding.

Extra consultations

Please bear in mind that we have included three one-on-one consultations (initial visit, another & your final consult approx. one month before) with our wedding coordinator into your package choice. Any additional one-on-one consultations or driving your photographer around the property will incur an extra cost.

Licensed premises

Makoura lodge is a licensed premise under the sale and supply of alcohol act 2012 and adheres to its obligations in that legislation, including not serving alcohol to underage or intoxicated guests. We have the right to require intoxicated guests to leave to their accommodation. In order to promote a safe drinking environment, we have the right to close the bar at any stage should the duty manager feel the need. No alcohol is to be brought into the venue or into our garden area, it will be confiscated.

Loss of goods

While every precaution is taken to ensure the safety of you and your guests, Makoura Lodge owners and/or staff will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to property (including vehicles) or injury to any person. Any items that have not been collected after the event will be disposed of within 30 days.

Meals for children

Meals for children between five and twelve years of age are 50% of the adult menu price. Meals for children under five years' old are complimentary. Children must have adult supervision at all times.

Minimum numbers

During our peak season (November to the end of April), our wedding packages are based upon a minimum of 60 adult guests or payment equal to that amount. From the start of June to the end of September and on Wednesdays no minimum guest numbers are required.

Miscellaneous

We reserve the right to change these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice. In the event that any changes are made, the revised terms and conditions shall be sent to you prior to your Wedding Date.

In the unlikely event that we need to cancel your reservation, we will provide you with as much written notice as possible.

You shall indemnify us in respect of all liability, claims and demands, actions, proceedings, damages, losses, costs and expenses of whatever nature which may be made by any third party which arise out of, or are in connection with, the performance of our services to you.

We will not be liable for any delay in performing or failure to perform any obligations under this agreement, if such delay or failure is caused by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the party and for which it is not responsible.

Payment of accounts

We require payment of your account 10-14 days prior to your wedding date. An invoice will be sent. A pre-paid account is accepted. Credit cards incur a 2.5% surcharge (subject to increase). Interest will be charged to overdue accounts at 10% per month. In the event of non-payment of any account you shall become liable for all recovery costs incurred by us, including but not limited to any legal expenses.

Pricing

All pricing is GST inclusive. Due to the reliance on our suppliers' charges, our prices are subject to change without notice. Please check our website prior to your wedding date about current menus and pricing, including but not limited to activities, accommodation, and additional requirements pricing.

Sustainability

In the interest of sustainability, we ask that you to be mindful about where supplied products are going after your wedding. Please consider composting, recycling, repurposing, or returning to the company. For this reason, items such as inorganic confetti, balloons, glitter, fireworks, sparklers, or smoke machines are not permitted on the property. Waste that is left that requires taking to a refuse station will incur a transport and disposal fee.

Surcharges on public holidays

Due to the increased cost of staffing on public holidays a 15% surcharge applies to activities, food, and beverages.

Tentative bookings

We tentatively reserve the venue for a maximum period of 14 days, after which if written confirmation and deposit is not received, we reserve the right to release your booking.

Pandemic Policy

Due to the dynamic nature of a pandemic and government regulations, each pandemic query is taken on an individual basis. Please refer to our website- About for more information.
